READ:

• 1 Peter 5:1-5, 6-11

REFLECT:

- Why does the church need more leaders than the pastor? Who are the leaders in your life? In your church? How have they been an example to you?
- Are you leading people to Christ or away with the example of your life?
- Daniel taught that a shepherd/leader protects, feeds the Word of God, and leads by example. What do you need to do to become the leader the Lord wants you to be?
- Do you consider yourself humble? Would others say you are humble? Is it easy to be humble when you're really good at something?
- Do you tend to do things on your own power/skills/abilities or by relying on the Lords power? In what areas of life do you let pride take over?
- What boundaries do you have in your life? What do you struggle with and therefore need to set a boundary for?
- Do you point others to Christ and the hope we have in Him? How would you define hope?

RESPOND:

Monday Morning Application: Evaluate how you are leading by looking at the example you are setting for those closest to you in your life. Ask the following:

- Is my posture correct?
- Am I allowing God to lead every aspect of my life?
- Do I have clear boundaries?
- Am I leaning into hope?
