READ:

REFLECT:

- What is one thing that you have learned through this study of the book of Nehemiah?
- Have you ever made a vow or a commitment to God and had a difficult time, like the Israelites, to stick to it? Looking back, what are some of the reasons why?
- We saw in chapter 13 that Eliashib made room for an enemy of God to live in the house of God (Temple). Has there been an area of your life or hear where you have allowed something that is not of God, live where He should live? (Since now, as Christians, we are the Temple of God. *1 Cor. 6:19-20*)
- Another area that we see the Israelites backslide is in keeping the sabbath. What do your sabbath practices look like? If you do not practice this...why?
- The final aspect of the vow that the Israelites break is marrying non-Israelites. An important question for us to ask is how do we engage the world around us while staying to true to the life that God has called us to live? How have you seen successes or failures in this in your own life?
- Jordan talked about how we cannot depend on “mountaintop experiences” to keep us faithful to God. Describe a mountaintop experience and how it impacted you.
