Closing - Pray together as a family that God would help your family to make wise decisions in your lives and help your family to obey His Words.

## Family Devotional Day 3

Open in Prayer

Bible Passage: Luke 10:25-37

Learn from Each Other:

- 1) What stood out to you from this story?
- 2) What does this story teach us about God?
- 3) What does this story teach us about relationships with other people?

Application:

- 1) How can we practice what we learned?

Closing - Each family member should share one way they could show love to someone. Pray together that God would help your family to demonstrate God's amazing love to other people.

Family Devotional Day 4

Opening Prayer Open ears to hear

Bible Passage: Matthew 6:25-34

Learn from Each Other:

- 1) What stood out to you from this story?
- 2) What does this story teach us about God?
- 3) What does this story teach us about relationships with other people?

Application:

- 1) How can we practice what we learned?

Closing Prayer - Each family member should share one thing they frequently worry about. Pray for one another, that God would help us to not worry, but rather focus on Him and His plan for our lives.
