## READ:

- Jonah 3:1-10
- Ephesians 6:12

## REFLECT:

- Has God ever called you on mission to do something uncomfortable? How did He use you despite your shortcomings?
- Do you tend to have trouble staying motivated and want to do the minimum to get the job done? How do you counteract that and keep yourself motivated?
- How do we do what God has called us to do with joy, hope, and love rather than bitterness and contempt?
- At the heart of discipleship to Jesus is obedience. How is your heart for service and obeying Him?
- How does obedience play a role in service? How important is it? What does it mean to obey completely?
- Have you ever treated God like a superstition? “If you do this, I’ll do ...” what made you want to do that? How did things turn out?
- How often do you consider factors of “spiritual warfare “ in your life?

## RESPOND:

### *Monday Morning Application:*

- Pray specifically this week for someone that you find difficult to love. Pray for your heart to be softened towards them and for them to draw close to Jesus.
