READ:

- Jonah 4:1-11
- Romans 12:9-21

REFLECT:

- Have you ever been disappointed when someone else got something they didn't deserve or that you thought you deserved??
- Have you ever been really angry at God? What was the source of your displeasure?
- How do you fight the temptation for arrogance in thinking that your beliefs are correct and everyone should agree?
- How do you wrestle with the tension of wanting God to work and act on your terms instead of His terms?

- Do you realize you are capable of any sin? How do we guard against that? What role does humbleness and repentance play?
- Reread Romans 12:9-21. How do we put this into action. Is there any part that you feel the Spirit is calling you to focus on more?
